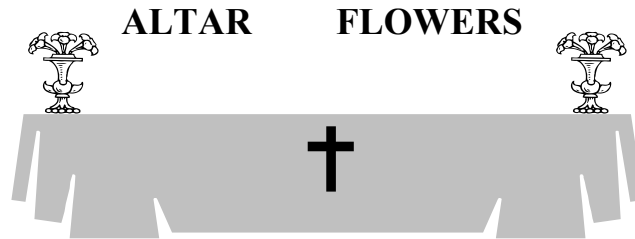

### **LET'S RECYCLE!**

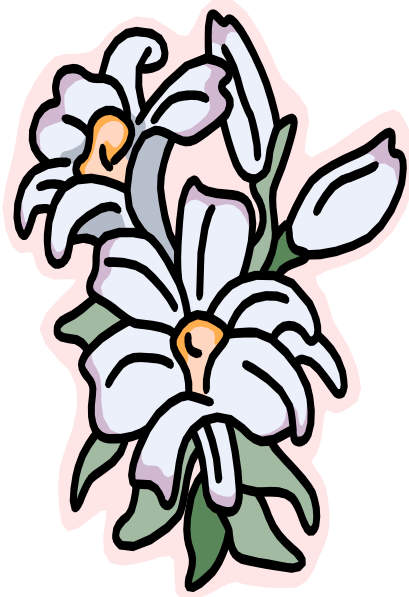
